Joining the Carpenters & Allied Workers Union in Alberta

- Carpenters and Allied Workers Union acts on behalf of tradespeople working at the trades we represent: Carpenters, Scaffolders, ISM/Drywallers and Roofers.
- Proof of time at the trade, tickets and certificates support your application.
- Entry level applicants will be reviewed.
- Assisting the Organizing Department is helpful in achieving membership.

What we need to see for proof

- The Union will not be your employer. Contractors will be. Resumes are not helpful as proof of past experience. Your credentials as a tradesperson have to be established for employment by our union contractors.
- Journeyman certificates and apprenticeship documents are proof of your level of achievement.
- The Union is also interested in you if you have learned your trade on job sites, working on the tools (time in the trade).
- Pay stubs or Records of Employment are proof of work experience. They help determine your skill status. These documents will be scrutinized for authenticity. Reference letters can be helpful if they are accompanied by the above documents.

Initiation Fees and Dues

- Membership Orientations are on scheduled days and you will be invited to attend once we accept your application. On the day of Orientation we require your dues of \$25.00 per month to be paid forward six months for a total of \$150.00, plus Local initiation and social fees. There are different fees between Edmonton/Fort McMurray (Local 1325) and Calgary/Red Deer (Local 2103). We do not accept money in advance.
- You will become a member when your application is processed, you have attended an orientation, your dues and fees are paid in full, and you have attended a local union meeting to swear in.
- It is recommended that you join the Local closest to your place of permanent residence.
